

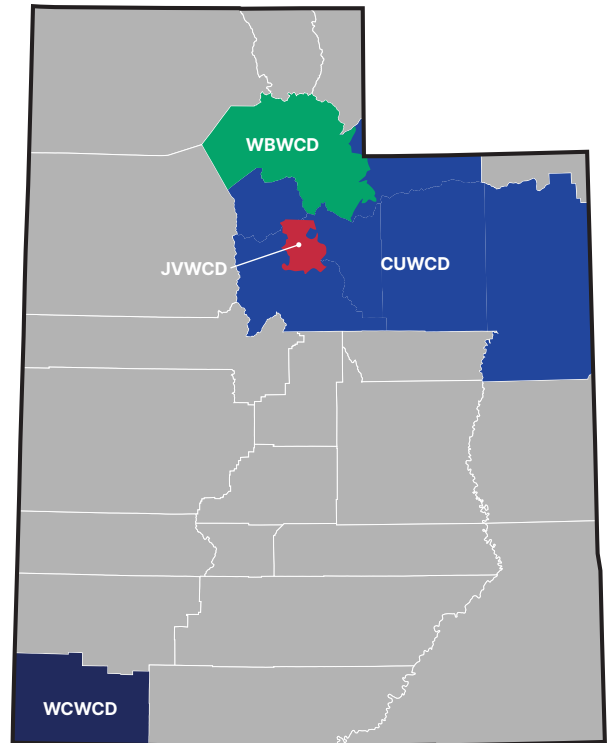
# Utah's Big Water Win

## More Than 215 Million Gallons Saved

Utah is making major strides in water conservation—saving **more than 215 million gallons of water** by replacing over **7.3 million square feet** of thirsty lawn with water-efficient landscaping.

- » 4,700 participants
- » \$16.8 million invested by the state and local water conservancy districts

And this isn't a one-time win. Once grass is replaced, the water savings continue every year.



## Why It Matters

Outdoor watering uses **nearly half of Utah's public water**. With rapid growth and persistent drought, using water more efficiently is essential.

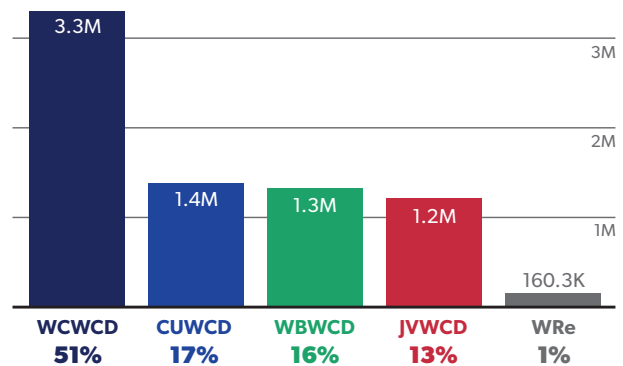
Water is the foundation of Utah's communities, economy and future. Water-wise landscapes help protect all three.
